For nearly 25 years, the LTAC-USFAA Artillery Schools, based at Ft. Sill, Oklahoma, the home of the US Field Artillery, have been the premier provider of the School of the Piece and the School of the Battery in the country. The Royal Hutt River Military College has developed the training materials for these schools, in conjunction with the LTAC-USFAA, and has helped create the current school curriculum used across the nation.

The cost per person is \$15.00, and includes one of the most comprehensive instruction manuals for the operation of muzzle-loading, black powder cannons in existence. The drills focus on full-scale smooth-bore and rifled guns, as well as mountain howitzers.

The school is open to artillerists, infantry, cavalry, and those just interested in artillery during the War Between the States. Topics covered during the school include: safety demonstrations, rolling powder charges, drills for servicing and loading the piece, Misfire drills, artillery commands and gun line safety.

Students who successfully complete the school will receive their qualification cards for the crew positions they learned. These qualifications are good for two years.
